Subject: Roof snaps tree instead of tree smashing roof

Dear Tim,

The quality of your work and your workers really showed a week ago. I was sitting in the corner of the bonus room that was part of the extension you built when a great crash occurred, just over my head.

Getting up to investigate, I saw a pine tree had snapped (center of picture), landing on the peak of the roof, only 2 feet from the driveway. The roof held, but impact snapped the pine in two. The top 25 feet rolled over the roof to land in the driveway, snapping again. The bottom 15 feet rolled along the roof in front to stop against the dormer. A small 3"x6" hole was punched in the plywood roofing, but the beams all held. And a small 8 inch triangle of siding was punched out of the dormer. It's amazing there was so little damage.
